

Scope

**NOTES TO AND FORMING PART OF THE FINANCIAL STATEMENTS**

**FOR THE YEAR ENDED 30 JUNE, 2010**

**1. STATEMENT OF SIGNIFICANT ACCOUNTING POLICIES**

The significant policies which have been adopted in the preparation of these financial statements are:

**1.1 BASIS OF PREPARATION**

The financial statements of the Union have been drawn up in accordance with applicable Accounting Standards, the RAO Schedule of the Fair Work (Registered Organisations) Act 2009 and other requirements of law. They have been prepared on the basis of historical costs and do not take into account changing money values or, except where stated, current valuations of non-current assets. The accounting policies have been consistently applied and, except where there is a change in accounting policy, are consistent with those of the previous year. The accounting records have been kept on an accrual basis.

**1.2 INCOME TAX**

No provision for income tax is necessary as the Union is exempt from income tax under Section 23(f) of the Income Tax Assessment Act.

**1.3 EMPLOYEE ENTITLEMENTS**

**Provision for Annual Leave**

The provision for employee entitlements to Annual Leave represents the amount which the Union has a present obligation to pay resulting from employees' services provided up to the balance date. The provision has been calculated at nominal amounts based on current wage and salary rates plus leave loading.

**2. PROVISION FOR LONG SERVICE LEAVE**

2.1 The liability for Long-Service Leave of Branch officials has been taken up in the books of account. Because this debt is still partly the responsibility of National Office, a corresponding asset exists under Current Assets (\$218,553).

2.2 In accordance with the decision of the National Executive, each Branch now brings to account the annual indebtedness to Long service Leave of its officials.

3. **SALARIES AND WAGES**

In accordance with Sub-regulations 107 (a) (XIV) and (XV) of the Fair Work (Registered Organisations) Act 2009, we report that the figure Salaries and Wages in the Statement of Financial Performance is made up of the following:-

4. **MATTERS SUBSEQUENT TO THE END OF THE FINANCIAL YEAR**

The Branch has entered into an agreement with the National Office to acquire a property in Percy Street, Portland. Under the arrangement, the Victorian Branch will meet all financial obligations in regard to the property although title will rest with National Office.

Apart from the above, the Branch Executive is not aware of any post-balance date event or contingent liability which may materially affect the operating results or financial position of the Branch for the year under review or in future years.

5. **INFORMATION TO BE PROVIDED TO MEMBERS OR REGISTRAR**

In accordance with the requirements of the Fair Work (Registered Organisations) Act 2009, the attention of members is drawn to the provisions of Section 274 which reads as follows:

- a) "A member of an organisation, or a Registrar, may apply to the organisation for specified prescribed information in relation to the organisation;
- b) An organisation shall, on application made under Subsection (1) by a member of the organisation or a Registrar, make the specified information available to a member or the Registrar in such manner, and within such time, as is prescribed;
- c) A Registrar may only make an application under Subsection (1) at the request of a member of the organisation concerned, and the Registrar shall provide to a member information received because of an application made at the request of the member."
