- the Audit report received was undated. The Auditors report needs to be dated in order to demonstrate compliance with the time scale requirements under the Act. The Auditors report should be dated on the same day, or after, the Accounting Officers Certificate and the Committee of Management certificate, to demonstrate that the Auditors gave an opinion based on, amongst other things, the information contained in these certificates. If you have a dated copy of the Audit Report it would be appreciated if you could supply a copy to the Registry.
- Paragraph (iv) of the Committee of Management Certificate makes reference to "the audited financial statement for the year ended 30 June 2002". The intention of the above statement as set out in regulation 109(1)(b)(iv) of the Workplace Relations Regulations is to certify that the organisation has complied with the Act in relation to the previous year's accounts. Accordingly, the references should have been to "the audited financial statement for the year ended 30 June 2002".
