To comply with the Unions Rules the following programme should be followed:



If the above requested programme is used the Role for voters closed on 30 June 2011 (Rule 8) and;  
the Role for candidates closed 6 months prior to the opening date for nominations (28 March 2010 - Rule 22 (4)).

The method of voting should be by the Optional Preferential system (Rule 23. (B) (2)).
