

The vacant positions are Casual Vacancies which occurred as a result of there being no nominations received for those positions during the Union's recent Annual Elections which were conducted by the AEC:


The Role for candidates will be deemed to have closed on a date which is 6 months prior to the date that nominations are called- Rule 22 (4)).
