Dear Sir,

On behalf of The Breweries & Bottleyards Employees' Industrial Union of Workers of Western Australia, I respectfully request you to arrange, under Section 189 (1) of the Fair Work (Registered Organisations) Act 2009, an election for the following positions:

For a two year term commencing on 7th December 2012 and ending on 7th December 2014:

President	(one position)
Trustee	(one position)
Committee Member	(two positions)

For a one year term commencing on 10th December 2010 and ending on 9th December 2011:

Trustee (casual vacancy)	(two positions)
--------------------------	-----------------

The reason for the election is that:

- a. The terms of office of the first 3 positions listed are due to expire in the normal course of events in accordance with the Unions Rules (Rule 10) and;
- b. The last two positions listed are casual vacancies which are currently unfilled.


The election should be conducted in accordance with the Unions Rules which provide that:

- Nominations must be called at least one month prior to the commencement of the ballot and must be open for at least 14 days. (Rule 23 (B) (1))
- The ballot must be open for at least 14 days and must close by 5 pm on the 3rd Wednesday in November (Rule 23 (A) (1))

- If the nominations for elections are called by 30th September , then the Role for voters closed on 30 June 2012 alternatively:
if the nominations for elections are called after 30th September, then the Role for voters will close on 30 September 2012 (Rule 8 (1)); and
- the Role for candidates closes 6 months prior to the opening date for nominations (Rule 22 (4)); and
- the method of voting should be by the Optional Preferential system (Rule 23. (B) (2)).
