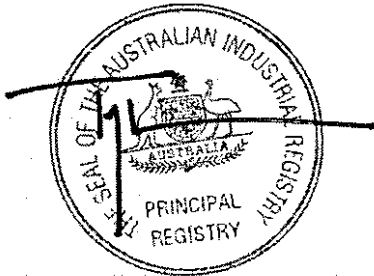
DECISION

Reasons for election

Election for the positions marked "A" are required as the Officers' term of tenure for those positions expire on 28 February 2005. (see rule 33(f)(ii))

Election for the positions marked "B" is required due to the resignation of the incumbent (a copy of the resignation letter is reproduced at "Attachment A").

Elected by:

The electorate for the direct voting system is the whole of each branch.

Nominations open:

All nominations for elections "*of the position of Officer of the Association as defined in rule 20 of these rules, conducted pursuant to these rules shall be received by the returning officer no later than the fourteenth (14th) day of January in the year in which the position becomes vacant*".

Nominations open in accordance with a timetable provided by the Returning Officer, delegated by the Australian Electoral Commission (AEC) keeping in mind Rule 35(d)(2)(b) that "*not later than the first day of January in any year, call for nominations for the Officer of the Association (Committee of Management) positions becoming vacant, pursuant to rule 38 of these rules, on the last day of February in that year; by insertion of notices in journals and/or circulars to members' employment facilities, as the returning officer deems appropriate*".

Nominations close:

Nominations close in accordance with a timetable provided by the Returning Officer, delegated by the Australian Electoral Commission (AEC).

One nomination:

Rule 35(d)(3)(b) states that "*where there is only one nomination accepted for any Officer of the Association (Committee of Management) position, declare that, as from the first (1st) day of March next, the nominee is elected to the position*".

Cut off date for roll:

in all cases; 7 days prior to the opening date for nominations.
