

Reasons for election:

Elections for the positions marked "A" are required under Civil Air Rule 34(e), which states "*Elections for Delegates representing the following divisions shall be conducted each even numbered year...*"

Elections for the positions marked "B" is required because a casual vacancy could not be filled for the position of Melbourne Towers and TCU Divisional Delegate during the recent Election run by the AEC (E2005/218).

Elected by:

For the position of Melbourne Centre, the electorate for the direct voting system is the Melbourne Centre.

For the position of Northern District, the electorate for the direct voting system is the Northern District.

For the positions of Sydney, Brisbane and Perth Towers and TCU, the electorate for the direct voting system is the Sydney Towers and TCU, Brisbane Towers and TCU and Perth Towers and TCU respectively.

For the casual vacancy of Melbourne Towers and TCU, the electorate for the direct voting system is the Melbourne Towers and TCU division.

Nominations open:

Nominations open in accordance with a timetable provided by the Returning Officer, delegated by the Australian Electoral Commission (AEC).

Nominations close:

As per Civil Air Rule 33(e), "All nominations for elections, of the position of Divisional Delegate ... shall be received by the returning officer no later than the fourteenth (14th) day of May in the year in which the position becomes vacant."

Cut off date for roll:

As per Civil Air Rule 35(g), "The roll of voters for any ballot is to be closed on the seventh day before the day on which nominations for the election open".
