Arrangements for the conduct of an Election (E2013/109)

I refer to the prescribed information dated 24 January 2013 which was lodged with the Fair Work Commission (FWC) on the same date for the conduct of an election for The Civil Air Operations Officers' Association of Australia.

Before an election can be arranged, FWC requires additional information. Section 189(2) of the Fair Work (Registered Organisations) Act 2009 states that the prescribed information must be lodged before the prescribed day, which under regulation 138(3) of the Fair Work (Registered Organisations) Regulations 2009, is two months before the first day when a person may become a candidate. Since s.189(2) is a penalty provision and the prescribed information for this election was not lodged before the prescribed day, the Delegate of the General Manager will now require a written request for an extension of time.

The written request for an extension of time to lodge the prescribed information must:
