**RE: LODGEMENT OF PRESCRIBED INFORMATION IN RELATION TO AN ELECTION FOR OFFICE IN AN ORGANISATION**

Pursuant to Section 189 of Schedule 1 of the Workplace Relations Act 1996, I hereby lodge in the Industrial Registry, the “*prescribed information*” specified in Regulation 138 of the *Workplace Relations (Registration and Accountability of Organisations) Regulations* in relation to the Civil Contractors Federation election of National Office Bearers to be conducted by the AEC:

**(d) *if the electorate comprises only members of a branch, section or other division of an organisation - the name of the branch, section or division;***

(e) ***the date and time of the beginning and end of the period in which nominations of candidates will be called for or may be made under the rules of the organisation or branch in relation to the election;***

(i) Nominations are required to be called within 7 days of the declaration of the election of all Board Members [see Rule 30]

*NB. The date fixed for the Annual General Meeting of the Branch is 11 November 2006.*

(f) ***the day provided for in the rules of the organisation as the day on which the roll of voters is to be closed;***

The roll of voters for any ballot shall close 7 days before the day on which nominations for the election open [see Rule 28].

(g) ***the kind of voting system to be used in the conduct of the election is:***

A direct voting system
