RE: LODGEMENT OF PRESCRIBED INFORMATION IN RELATION TO AN ELECTION FOR OFFICE IN AN ORGANISATION

Pursuant to Section 189 of the *Fair Work (Registered Organisations) Act 2009*, I hereby lodge with Fair Work Australia, the “*prescribed information*” specified in Regulation 138 of the *Fair Work (Registered Organisation) 200 Regulations* in relation to the Civil Contractors Federation election of National Office Bearers to be conducted by the AEC:

Prescribed information

(a) *the name of each office or position for which an election is required;*

- (i) National President (1)
- (ii) National Vice President (1)
- (iii) Honorary Treasurer (1)

(b) *the reason for the election is that:*

The terms of office are due to expire in the normal course of events under the rules of the organisation.

(c) *if more than one of the offices or positions for which an election is required has the same name, and the number of offices or positions can, under the rules of the relevant organisation or branch, be determined before the prescribed day - the number of those offices or positions;*

- (i) n/a

(d) *if the electorate comprises only members of a branch, section or other division of an organisation - the name of the branch, section or division;*

National Board Members

(e) ***the date and time of the beginning and end of the period in which nominations of candidates will be called for or may be made under the rules of the organisation or branch in relation to the election;***

(i) Nominations are required to be called within 7 days of the declaration of the election of all Board Members [see Rule 30]

NB. The date fixed for the Annual General Meeting of the Members of the Federation is 21 October 2010.

(f) ***the day provided for in the rules of the organisation as the day on which the roll of voters is to be closed;***

The roll of voters for any ballot shall close 7 days before the day on which nominations for the election open [see Rule 28].

(g) ***the kind of voting system to be used in the conduct of the election is:***

A direct voting system.
