RE: LODGEMENT OF PRESCRIBED INFORMATION IN RELATION TO AN ELECTION FOR OFFICE IN AN ORGANISATION

Pursuant to Section 189 of Schedule 1 of the Workplace Relations Act 1996, I hereby lodge in the Industrial Registry, the "prescribed information" specified in Regulation 138 of the Workplace Relations (Registration and Accountability of Organisations) Regulations in relation to the Civil Contractors Federation ACT Branch election to be conducted by the AEC:

Prescribed information

- (a) the name of each office or position for which an election is required;
 - (i) Board Member (1)
 - (ii) Alternate Board Member (1)
 - (iii) Branch President (1)
 - (iv) Branch Vice President (1)
 - (v) Branch Honorary Treasurer (1)
 - (vi) Branch Board Member (4)
- (b) the reason for the election is that:

The terms of office are due to expire in the normal course of events under the rules of the organisation.

(c) if more than one of the offices or positions for which an election is required has the same name, and the number of offices or positions can, under the rules of the relevant organisation or branch, be determined before the prescribed day - the number of those offices or positions;

- (i) Branch Board Member (4)
- (d) if the electorate comprises only members of a branch, section or other division of an organisation the name of the branch, section or division;

Members of the Civil Contractors Federation ACT Branch.

- (e) the date and time of the beginning and end of the period in which nominations of candidates will be called for or may be made under the rules of the organisation or branch in relation to the election;
 - (i) Nominations shall be called for not less than fifty days in advance of the date fixed for the Annual General Meeting [see Rule 29(b) and Rule 50(a)(i)]
 - NB. The date fixed for the Annual General Meeting of the Branch is Tuesday 13 October 2009 therefore nominations must be called prior to 20 August 2009.
 - (ii) The closing date for nominations shall be not less than thirty days before the date of the Annual General Meeting. [see Rule 29(c) and Rule 50(a)(i)]

NB. The proposed date for the Branch Annual General Meeting is 13 October 2009 therefore the closing date for nominations is 17 August 2009.

(f) the day provided for in the rules of the organisation as the day on which the roll of voters is to be closed;

The roll of voters for any ballot shall close 7 days before the day on which nominations for the election open [see Rule 28].

NB. As the date fixed for the Annual General Meeting of the Branch is 13 October 2009 and nominations open on 3 August 2009, the roll of voters is to be closed on 27 July 2009.

(g) the kind of voting system to be used in the conduct of the election is:

A direct voting system [see Rule 29(f)(iii) and Rule 50(e)(iii)]
