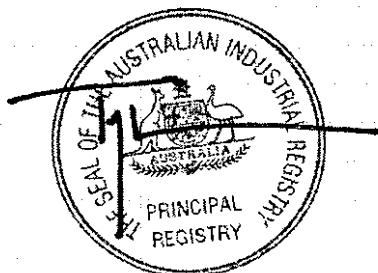

Application is hereby made pursuant to Section 214 and Regulation 61 of the Workplace Relations Act 1996 to have an election conducted by the Australian Electoral Commission for the election of officers of the NSW Branch of the Civil Contractors Federation.
