NB. The proposed date for the NSW Branch Annual General Meeting is 26 September 2008, therefore the closing date for nominations is 27 August 2008

(f) the day provided for in the rules of the organisation as the day on which the roll of voters is to be closed;

The roll of voters for any ballot shall close 7 days before the day on which nominations for the election open [see Rule 28 the Civil Contractors Federation Constitution].

NB. As the date fixed for the Annual General Meeting of the Branch is 26 September 2008 and nominations open on 7 August 2008, the roll of voters is to be closed on 31 July 2008.
