Section 197(1) of Schedule 1 of the Workplace Relations Act 1996 requires the AEC to provide a written report on the conduct of the election to the Industrial Registrar and to the organisation or branch for whom the election was conducted. Further, Regulation 141(4) of the Workplace Relations (RAO) Regulations requires an organisation or branch to publish a notice on its web site advising members that a copy of the post election report is available upon request. If a website is not available, publishing a notice in a journal or newsletter would be considered appropriate.

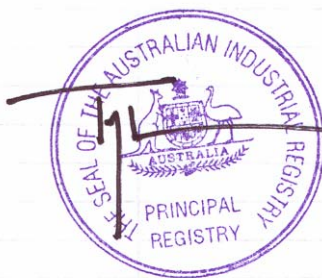

*NB. The date fixed for the Annual General Meeting of the Branch is 13 September 2007, therefore nominations must be called prior to 24 July 2007 and will be called on 12 July 2007.*

(ii) The closing date for nominations shall be not less than thirty days before the date of the Annual General Meeting. [see Rule 29(c) and Rule 50(a)(i)]

*NB. The proposed date for the Branch Annual General Meeting is 13 September 2007, therefore the closing date for nominations must be prior to 14 August 2007 and will close on 2 August 2007.*

(f) *the day provided for in the rules of the organisation as the day on which the roll of voters is to be closed;*

The roll of voters for any ballot shall close 7 days before the day on which nominations for the election open [see Rule 28].

*NB. As the date fixed for the Annual General Meeting of the Branch is 13 September 2007 and nominations open on 12 July 2007, the roll of voters is to be closed on 5 July 2007.*

(g) *the kind of voting system to be used in the conduct of the election is:*


