Arrangement for conduct of election.

[1] On 27 May 2013 the Civil Contractors Federation - Northern Territory Branch lodged with the Fair Work Commission the prescribed information in relation to an election for the following offices:

[2] The prescribed information was not lodged before the day prescribed by Regulation 138(3) of the *Fair Work (Registered Organisations) Regulations 2009.* That day is the day occurring 2 months before the first day when a person may, under the rules of the organisation or branch, become a candidate in the election.
