Rule/s re eligibility to vote: 6, 46

Rules difficult to apply/interpret: 28(c)(iv)(i) & 28(c)(viii)(b) There is an inconsistency

with these rules in that 28(c)(iv)(i) says to place the figures 1,2,3,4 etc against the name of each and every candidate otherwise the ballot paper will be informal while 28(c)(viii)(b) says a vote shall be informal if a voter votes for a greater or lesser number of candidates than the number of offices to be filled.

46(e)(iii) & 46(e)(x) There is an inconsistency with these rules in that 46(e)(iii) indicates that a preferential system will be used based on rule 28(c)(iv) however 46(e)(x) says the candidate/s with the highest number of votes shall be deemed to be the successful candidate/s which could refer to a first past the post system.

28(c)(iv)(iii)(a) It would be extremely difficult to apply this rule, and meet the election timetable, to exclude a candidate where the least number of votes was received by two or more candidates, as the rule requires another postal ballot to be conducted to determine which of the candidates is eliminated. After this step the original count would resume to determine who was elected.
