RE: LODGEMENT OF PRESCRIBED INFORMATION IN RELATION TO AN ELECTION FOR OFFICE IN AN ORGANISATION

Pursuant to Section 189 of the Fair Work (Registered Organisations) Act 2009, I hereby lodge with Fair Work Australia, the "prescribed information" specified in Regulation 138 of the Fair Work (Registered Organisation) 200 Regulations in relation to the Civil Contractors Federation Tasmania election to be conducted by the AEC:

Prescribed information

(a) the name of each office or position for which an election is required;

Branch Board

- (i) Branch President (1)
- (ii) Branch Vice President (1)
- (iii) Branch Honorary Treasurer (1)
- (iv) Branch Board Member (7)

Board of the Federation

- (v) National Board Member (1)
- (vi) Alternate National Board Member (1)
- (b) the reason for the election is that:

The terms of office are due to expire in the normal course of events under the rules of the organisation.

(c) if more than one of the offices or positions for which an election is required has the same name, and the number of offices or positions can, under the rules of the relevant organisation or branch, be determined before the prescribed day - the number of those offices or positions;

Branch Board Member - Nil

(d) if the electorate comprises only members of a branch, section or other division of an organisation - the name of the branch, section or division;

Members of the Civil Contractors Federation Tasmanian Branch

- (e) the date and time of the beginning and end of the period in which nominations of candidates will be called for or may be made under the rules of the organisation or branch in relation to the election;
 - (i) Nominations shall be called for not less than fifty days in advance of the date fixed for the Branch Annual General Meeting

NB. The date fixed for the Annual General Meeting of the Branch is 14th September 2010, therefore nominations must be called prior to 28th July.

(ii) The closing date for nominations shall be not less than thirty days before the date of the Branch Annual General Meeting.

NB. The proposed date for the Branch Annual General Meeting is14th September 2010, therefore the closing date for nominations is 13th August 2010.

(f) the day provided for in the rules of the organisation as the day on which the roll of voters is to be closed;

The roll of voters for any ballot shall close 7 days before the day on which nominations for the election open.

NB. As the date fixed for the Annual General Meeting of the Branch is 14th September 2010 and nominations open on 28th July 2010, the roll of voters is to be closed on 21st July 2010.

(g) the kind of voting system to be used in the conduct of the election is:

A direct voting system
