NB. The proposed date for the Branch Annual General Meeting is 26^{th} September 2007, therefore the closing date for nominations is 25^{th} August 2007.

(f) the day provided for in the rules of the organisation as the day on which the roll of voters is to be closed;

The roll of voters for any ballot shall close 7 days before the day on which nominations for the election open [see Rule 28].

NB. As the date fixed for the Annual General Meeting of the Branch is 26th September 2007 and nominations open on 6th August 2007, the roll of voters is to be closed on 25th August 2007.
