RE: LODGEMENT OF PRESCRIBED INFORMATION IN RELATION TO AN ELECTION FOR OFFICE IN AN ORGANISATION

Pursuant to Section 189 of the *Fair Work (Registered Organisations) Act 2009*, I hereby lodge with Fair Work Australia, the "prescribed information" specified in Regulation 138 of the *Fair Work (Registered Organisation) Regulations 2009* in relation to the Civil Contractors Federation [Victoria] election to be conducted by the AEC:

Prescribed information

- (a) *the name of each office or position for which an election is required;*

Branch Board [Rule 43 and 50]

- (i) Branch President (1)
- (ii) Branch Vice President (1)
- (iii) Branch Honorary Treasurer (1)
- (iv) Branch Board Member (8)

National Board of the Federation [Rule 25 and Rule 29]

- (v) National Board Member (1)
- (vi) Alternate National Board Member (1)

- (b) *the reason for the election is that:*

The terms of office are due to expire in the normal course of events under the rules of the organisation.

- (c) *if more than one of the offices or positions for which an election is required has the same name, and the number of offices or positions can, under the rules of the relevant organisation or branch, be determined before the prescribed day - the number of those offices or positions;*

- (d) *if the electorate comprises only members of a branch, section or other division of an organisation - the name of the branch, section or division;*

(e) *the date and time of the beginning and end of the period in which nominations of candidates will be called for or may be made under the rules of the organisation or branch in relation to the election;*

(i) Nominations shall be called for not less than fifty days in advance of the date fixed for the Branch Annual General Meeting [see Rule 29(c) and Rule 50(b)(i)]

NB. The date fixed for the Annual General Meeting of the Branch is [13/09/2013], therefore nominations must be called prior to [23/07/2013].

(ii) The closing date for nominations shall be not less than thirty days before the date of the Branch Annual General Meeting. [see Rule 29(d) and Rule 50(b)(i)]

NB. The proposed date for the Branch Annual General Meeting is [13/09/2013], therefore the closing date for nominations is [13/08/2013].

(f) *the day provided for in the rules of the organisation as the day on which the roll of voters is to be closed;*

The roll of voters for any ballot shall close 7 days before the day on which nominations for the election open [see Rule 28].

NB. As the date fixed for the Annual General Meeting of the Branch is [13/09/2013] and nominations open on [23/07/2013], the roll of voters is to be closed on [15/07/2013].

(g) *the kind of voting system to be used in the conduct of the election is:*

A direct voting system [see Rule 29(g)(iii) and Rule 50(f)(iii)]
