
The Communications, Electrical, Electronic, Energy, Information, Postal, Plumbing and Allied Services Union of Australia Communications Division, Western Australian Branch (the Branch) held scheduled quadrennial elections in 2019.

Under rule 65(a) of the CEPU rules covering the Communications Division, branch office holders take up office from the 1 August in the year of election following the declaration of the office. Since taking up office, a member of the Branch Committee of Management, Peter Noble, resigned on 15 May 2020.

Rule 69 requires that an election be conducted where a Branch Committee of Management position becomes vacant for any reason and the unexpired part of the term is more than twelve (12) months or three quarters of the term of office before the date of the closing of the ballot for the next election, whichever is the greater. As further required by rule 69, the Branch Committee of Management at its scheduled meeting held 20 May 2020 declared the vacancy.

Accordingly, the Division requests that the Registered Organisations Commission arrange for an election to be conducted by the Australian Electoral Commission for the office set out in the attached prescribed information.
