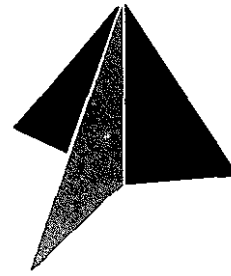




STATEMENT

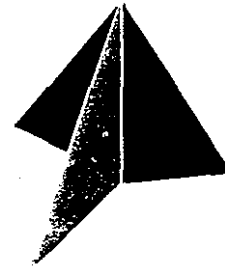

RE: P&T BCOM NUMBERS FOR 2003 ELECTIONS RULE 77(d)

Your attention is drawn to sub-Rules 77(d) (ii) and (iii) which states:

Dear Colleague,

I refer to my previous letter of 29th January 2003 (BR 03/42 refers) which unfortunately failed to refer to changes relating to this rule which are currently being dealt with by the Industrial Registrar. However, I have received today the attached letter from the New South Wales Telecommunications and Services Branch seeking action to abolish another position that being the Assistant Secretary position vacated by Mark Brownlow. The Branch is seeking to abolish the position pursuant to Rule 71A of the Communications Division's rules. Rule 71A states:

71A - CASUAL VACANCIES-BRANCH OFFICERS-FULL TIME POSITIONS

- (a) *Notwithstanding anything contained in Rules 70 and 71, where an office of a full-time officer (other than the position of a full-time Branch President or a full-time Branch Secretary) becomes vacant more than 56 days prior to the opening of nominations for the next election of the office concerned as provided by Rule 68.*
- (i) *In the case of Telecommunications and Services Branches, a General Meeting may resolve to abolish the office. Where a General Meeting is not scheduled within one calendar month of the office becoming vacant, or is called but lapses for lack of a quorum, the Committee of Management shall be empowered to resolve to abolish the office.*
- (ii) *In the case of Postal and Telecommunications Branches, the Branch Committee of Management may resolve to abolish the office.*
- (b) *Where the abolition of an office referred to in sub-rule (a) would result in no Divisional representation for a particular Division in the Branch office:*
- (i) *In the case of Telecommunications and Services Branches, a General Meeting may resolve to abolish the office or convert the office to an Honorary office. Where a General Meeting is not scheduled within a calendar month of the office becoming vacant, or it is called for but lapses for want of a quorum, the Branch Committee of Management shall be empowered to resolve to abolish the office, or to convert the office to an honorary office.*
- (ii) *In the case of Postal and Telecommunications Branches, the Branch Committee of Management may resolve to abolish the office, or to convert the office to an honorary office.*

- (c) *Where the Branch General Meeting or Committee of Management, as the case may be, resolves to abolish an office or to convert an office to an honorary office as referred to in sub-rule (a) or (b) hereof, the Branch Secretary shall refer the resolution to the Divisional Secretary who shall in accordance with Rule 11(b) submit to Divisional Conference within 14 days:*
 - (i) *the resolution to abolish the office, or to convert the office to an honorary office, as the case may be, for endorsement; and*
 - (ii) *the necessary rule changes required under the rules to abolish the office concerned or to convert the office concerned to an honorary office.*
- (d) *Divisional Conference shall deal with the ratification of the Branch General Meeting or Committee of Management resolution and the required rule changes in accordance with the provisions of Rule 11(b), (c), (d) and (e).*
- (e) *Pending requirements of sub-rules (a), (b) and (c) and the certification of the rule changes by an Industrial Registrar, the provisions of Rules 70 and 71 shall not apply.*

It would therefore be more practical to deal with the abolition of the Organiser position referred to in my letter of 29 January 2003 and the Assistant Secretary position at the same time. The approach suggested is as per my previous letter of 29th January 2003 which would now entail.

1. Pursuant to National sub-rule 7.7.1 the National Executive Officers agree to put the following motion to National Council following confirmation that the Communications Divisions Divisional Conference has approved the proposal to amend Rule 91 in the following terms:-

"That sub-rules 91(e),(f), (h) and (i) of the Communications Division's rules be amended to read:-



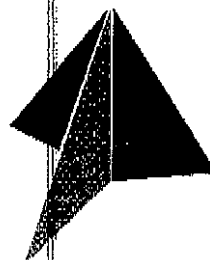
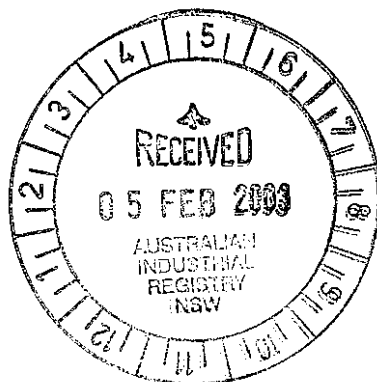

On 3rd February 2003 we wrote to your office forwarding a written statement detailing the prescribed information in relation to the CEPU's Communications Divisions forthcoming elections.

On 5th February 2003 the Divisional Office received written advice of certification of alteration to Rules (R No. 2003/9) including Rule 92 (a) (i) and (ii). That sub-rule now is as follows:

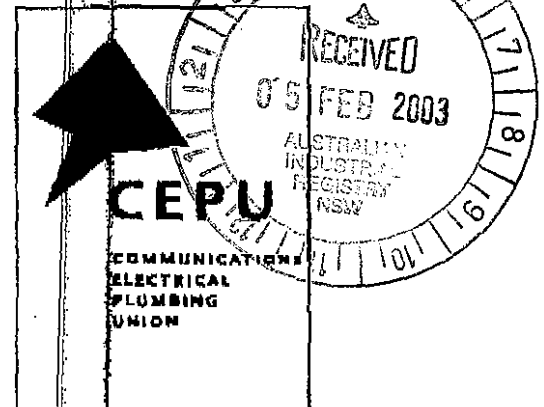
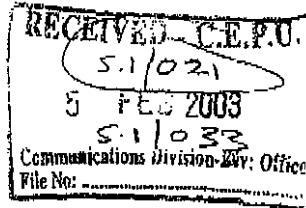

TASMANIAN T&S BRANCH COMMITTEE OF MANAGEMENT NUMBERS

This letter is a follow-up to my letter of 29 January on the above topic.

In that letter I advised you that *"In respect to the number of members of the Committee of Management please be advised that the position properly determined by the Tasmanian BCOM is:*

"That the number of BCOM members for both Technical and Operator Divisional Section representation on the Tasmanian T&S Branch Committee of Management shall be the minimum number provided for under the terms of the CEPU Rules."

I further advised that accordingly, the number for Tasmanian T&S Branch BCOM is 5 Technical and 3 Operator.

In establishing those numbers, I used what I believed to be the most up to date copy of the Rules available, using the CEPU web site, and on the understanding that the web site information is directly linked to the official repository of the Rules.

In my letter, I did go on to say that I had thought that the Rules had been amended to reduce the minimum number of positions required by the Branch but that I had not found the Registered Rules to not appear to reflect any change.

I have now been made aware of the contents of BR 02/913 (5.0/401) which appears to confirm that there were in fact changes to Rule 92 which were the subject of a certificate issued on 18 October 2002 by the Deputy Industrial

Registrar. It would appear that these changes to Rule 92 were omitted from an earlier certificate.

I do not understand why the Rules accessible from the web site do not reflect these changes.

In the light of all the above, I request that you amend the Branch Committee of Management numbers for the Tasmanian T&S Branch to reflect "the minimum number provided for under the terms of the CEPU Rules," that is three representatives from Technical Divisional Section and One representative from the Operator Divisional Section.

I am sorry for this inconvenience which seems to be the culmination of a whole series of misadventures.

In accordance with Rule 71A we now request that you initiate action to circulate the necessary rule changes to effect the abolition of this position.

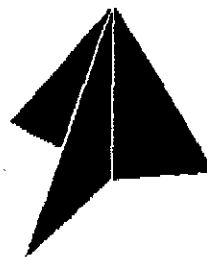

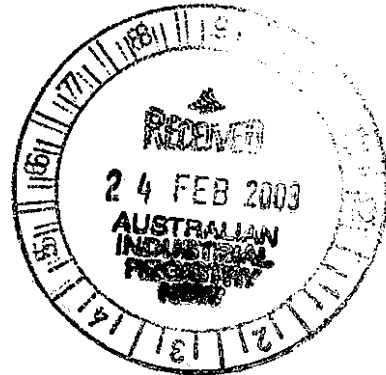
