Re: Prescribed Information in Relation to an Election (E2012/304)

I refer to the prescribed information (the PI) that was lodged and dated 19 June 2012 in relation to elections for numerous divisional and branch officers of the Communications Division of the Communications, Electrical, Electronic, Energy, Information, Postal, Plumbing and Allied Services Union of Australia (CEPU) due to casual vacancies and offices not being filled at the last election.

Before Fair Work Australia (FWA) can further consider arranging for the conduct of the election by the Australian Electoral Commission (AEC) pursuant to s. 189(3) of the Fair Work (Registered Organisations) Act 2009 the following issues need to be addressed:

- 1. The names of each office for which an election is required as listed in the PI are not entirely clear. Based on the rules of the Communications Division of the CEPU (the rules) FWA has attempted to identify the offices referred to in the PI. Attached to this letter and marked "Annexure A" is a list of the offices provided in the PI with the corresponding office provided in the rules which FWA believes the PI is referring to. Could you please confirm whether the offices FWA believes the PI is referring to are correct.
- 2. The PI provides for a list of offices which an election is required due to a casual vacancy arising or for those offices not being filled at the previous election. Two offices listed as requiring an election due to not being filled at the previous election appear to include the following:
  - Branch Committee of Management Member, Postal Services Industry Section, South Australia and Northern Territory Communications Branch; and
  - Branch Committee of Management Member, Telecommunications and Information Technology Industry Section, South Australia and Northern Territory Communications Branch.

However, the Declaration of Results issued by the AEC on 13 May 2011 in relation to the last election for the South Australia and Northern Territory Communications Branch (E2011/2512) indicates that all six of the potential offices of Branch Committee of

Management Member for each Industry Section were filled at that election. Attached to this letter and marked "Annexure B" is an extract of the Declaration of Results issued on 13 May 2011. The most recent annual return lodged by the Communications Division of the CEPU (AR2012/229) indicates that two persons elected to the above offices during the last election no longer appear to hold these offices. More specifically, the missing (former) office holders are:

- Michael Tippins, Branch Committee of Management Member, Postal Services Industry Section, South Australia and Northern Territory Communications Branch; and
- Gerry Kandelaars, Branch Committee of Management Member, Telecommunications and Information Technology Industry Section, South Australia and Northern Territory Communications Branch.

If these (former) office holders have resigned their office and/or membership of the CEPU, the PI needs to indicate that a casual vacancy election is required for these two offices and a copy of their resignation, or other documentary evidence, needs to be lodged with the PI to confirm the casual vacancies.

Alternatively, if these individuals are currently office holders, could you please advise FWA.

- 3. Regulation 138(1) of the *Fair Work (Registered Organisations) Regulations 2009* provides that the PI, in addition to the name of each office for which an election is required and the number of such offices, must contain:
  - if the electorate comprises only members of a branch, section or other division of an organisation the name of the branch, section or division;
  - the date and time of the beginning and end of the period in which nominations of candidates will be called or may be made under the rules of the organisation or branch;
  - the day provided for in the rules of the organisation as the day on which the roll of voters is to be closed; and
  - whether a direct voting system or a collegiate electoral system is to be used.

The PI does not address the above four issues. In order to assist you in this regard, I have attached at "Annexure C" the results of FWA's examination of the rules. Please read this carefully and independently verify whether this information is correct as it is only intended as a recommendation.

4. The PI also requests an election for one Divisional Conference Postal Member which we believe should actually be for the office of Divisional Conference Delegate, Postal Services Industry Section. This appears to be for the office held by Mr Steve Douglas however FWA has not been provided any information whether Mr Douglas has resigned or whether he has ceased to hold that office for another reason. Could you provide FWA with detailed information regarding the circumstances behind this vacancy.

In order the remedy the application, your organisation will need to lodge amended prescribed information addressing the above four issues together with any potential documentary evidence of the resignations of the (former) office holders referred to above.
