



NOTES TO AND FORMING PART OF THE ACCOUNTS FOR THE YEAR ENDED 31 MARCH 2003

1. STATEMENT OF ACCOUNTING POLICIES

The financial report has been prepared on a going concern basis, which contemplates continuity of normal operating activities and the realisation of assets and settlement of liabilities in the normal course of the union's operations.

The continuing operations of the union and the ability to pay its debts in the normal course is dependant upon the financial support of Communications Electrical Electronic Energy Information Postal Plumbing and Allied Services Union of Australia, Communications Division, Divisional Conference and upon the success of future operations.

If the union is unable to continue as a going concern, it may be required to realise its assets and extinguish its liabilities other than in the normal course of business and at amounts different from those stated in the financial report.

The financial report has been prepared and presented in accordance with applicable Accounting Standards, other mandatory professional reporting requirements and the Workplace Relations Act, 1996. The financial report has also been prepared on the basis of historical costs and does not take into account changing money values or, except where stated, current valuations of non-current assets. The concept of accruals accounting has been adopted in the preparation of the financial report. The accounting policies have been consistently applied, unless otherwise stated.

The following is a summary of the significant accounting policies adopted in the preparation of the financial report.

- a) Depreciation of fixed assets is calculated on the straight line basis in order to write the assets off over their useful lives to the union.
- b] Provision for employee benefits in the form of Long Service Leave and Accrued Annual Leave have been made for the estimated accrued entitlements of all employees on the basis of their terms of employment.
 - In the case of Long Service Leave, the accrual has been measured by reference to periods of service and current salary rates as it is considered that this results in an amount not materially different to that achieved by discounting estimated future cash flows.
- c] Members' Dues are accounted for on a cash receipts basis.
- d) No provision for Income Tax is necessary as the Union is exempt from Income Tax under Section 50-15 of the Income Tax Assessment Act 1997.


