Re: CEPU - Communications Division-South Australian & Northern Territory Telecommunications & Services Branch - Financial Reporting Obligations under *Workplace Relations Act 1996*

This is a courtesy letter to remind you of the financial reporting obligations of the abovenamed body under the *Workplace Relations Act 1996* ('the Act') for the financial year ended 31 March, 2004.

While the accounting, auditing and reporting obligations have changed with the introduction of the *Registration and Accountability of Organisations* Schedule (the RAO Schedule) which generally came into operation on 12 May 2003, Part IX, Division 11 of the Act continues to apply in relation to a financial year of an organisation that ends on 31 March, 2004. The corresponding obligations set out in the RAO Schedule apply to each financial year of an organisation that starts on or after 1 July 2003.

Now that the financial year for 31 March, 2004 has ended, it is timely that you put in train the various steps of the financial reporting requirements. To assist you with this process I have enclosed for your information a notice summarising these requirements including the time-scales prescribed by the legislation.

Please note that a branch of an organisation may be exempted from the accounting, auditing and reporting obligations in respect of a financial year by satisfying a Registrar that the branch did not have any financial affairs during the financial year. An application under subsection 271A(1) of the Act must be made within 90 days (unless extended by a Registrar) after the end of the financial year.





- "(1) A Member of an Organisation, or a Registrar, may apply to the Organisation for specified prescribed information in relation to the Organisation.
- (2) An Organisation shall, on application made under Sub-Section (1) by a Member of the Organisation or Registrar, make the specified information available to the Member or Registrar in such manner, and within such time as is prescribed.
- (3) A Registrar may only make an application under Sub-Section (1) at the request of a Member of the Organisation concerned, and the Registrar shall provide to a Member information received because of an application made at the request of the Member."

An Organisation shall not contravene Section 274 (1), (2) and (3). Penalty \$1,000.

Certificates required to be given under the Act, by the Accounting Officer and the Committee of Management, have been completed in accordance with the provisions of the Act, and contain no qualifications.

NOTES TO AND FORMING PART OF THE ACCOUNTS For the Year Ended 31 March, 2004

NOTE 1 ACCOUNTING METHODS

The Accounts are prepared under the Historical Cost Convention and in accordance with the Accounting Standards jointly issued by the Australian Professional Accounting Bodies. In particular:

- (a) The Accounts have not been adjusted to record either changes in the general purchasing power of the dollar or in the prices of specific Assets.
- (b) **Plant and Equipment** Plant and equipment are brought to account at cost less accumulated depreciation.
- (c) Provision for Employee Benefits in the form of Long Service Leave, Accrued Annual Leave, etc., has been made for the estimated accrued entitlements of Employees on the basis of their terms of employment.
- (d) Income Tax The Union is exempt from Income Tax under S50-15 of the ITAA 1997.
- (e) Contributions Excepting for Contributions in Advance, Contributions have been accounted for on a cash basis.

In accordance with the requirements of the Workplace Relations Act, 1996, the attention of Members is drawn to the provisions of Sub-Sections (1), (2) and (3) of Section 274, which reads as follows:

(2) An Organisation shall, on application made under Sub-Section (1) by a Member of the Organisation or Registrar, make the specified information available to the Member or Registrar in such manner, and within such time as is prescribed.

(3) A Registrar may only make an application under Sub-Section (1) at the request of a Member of the Organisation concerned, and the Registrar shall provide to a Member information received because of an application made at the request of the Member."



TELSTRA MUST END AWA SCARE CAMPAIGN

Telstra must make it clear to their employees that the abolition of AWAs will have no detrimental impact of their conditions of employment.

Telstra has been holding briefings and has emailed its employees, suggesting that their employment conditions could be jeopardised if a Latham Labor Government abolishes AWAs. Telstra has told employees they can only have "....certainty in their employment arrangements...." if they sign new AWAs.

Labor calls on Telstra to make it clear to employees that any condition of employment that can be in an AWA can also be in collective agreements (or 'EBAs' as they are known within Telstra) including salary sacrificing, career breaks and flexible leave arrangements.

The latest question and answer document provided to Telstra's managers proves yet again that AWAs are not negotiated with each employee, but are given to employees on a 'take-it-or-leaveit' basis. Telstra's managers are told to respond to the question "Can I vary the wording in the AWA?" by saying "No". Employees are advised that "Your manager will determine the most appropriate type of AWA to offer you based on your current role". (1)

Whatever the second 'A' in AWA stands for, in Telstra's case it certainly doesn't stand for 'Agreement' - perhaps it's 'Acquiescence'.

AWAs are designed to assist large employers like Telstra to force whatever working conditions they want onto employees.

- (2) An Organisation shall, on application made under Sub-Section (1) by a Member of the Organisation or Registrar, make the specified information available to the Member or Registrar in such manner, and within such time as is prescribed.
- (3) A Registrar may only make an application under Sub-Section (1) at the request of a Member of the Organisation concerned, and the Registrar shall provide to a Member information received because of an application made at the request of the Member."

An Organisation shall not contravene Section 274 (1), (2) and (3). Penalty \$1,000.

Certificates required to be given under the Act, by the Accounting Officer and the Committee of Management, have been completed in accordance with the provisions of the Act, and contain no qualifications.
