Could you please amend the above decision to require 4 elected Organisers in the West Australian State Branch.



Please be advised that pursuant to <u>Sections 182(1) and 189 of Schedule 1 ("RAO</u> <u>Schedule") of the Workplace Relations Act 1996. ("WRA")</u> the Electrical, Energy and Services Division of the CEPU is required, in accordance with its rules, to conduct a number of elections at a Divisional and Divisional Branch level. The elections required at a Divisional level are detailed in Attachment A of this correspondence and requirements of Divisional Branches are detailed in Attachment B. I have also enclosed a statement pursuant to <u>Section 189(1) of Schedule 1 of WRA</u> which prescribes information as required by <u>Regulation 138 of the RAO Regulations</u> for the Divisional quadrennial elections.

These elections will require further statements pursuant to <u>Sections 182(1) and 189 of the RAO Schedule and Regulation 138 of RAO Regulations</u> and the documentation with respect to these elections will be lodged once the quadrennial election process has been completed.
