[3] On 22 June 2012, the Electrical, Energy and Services Division of the abovenamed organisation lodged a written request for an extension of time for lodgment in accordance with s.189(2) of the Act.

I refer to the prescribed information dated 13 June 2012 which was lodged with Fair Work Australia (**FWA**) on 15 June 2012 for the conduct of a scheduled election for offices of the Electrical, Energy and Services Division of the Communications, Electrical, Electronic, Energy, Information, Postal, Plumbing and Allied Services Union of Australia (CEPU).

Section 189(2) of the *Fair Work (Registered Organisations) Act 2009* states that prescribed information must be lodged before the prescribed day, which under regulation 138(3) of the *Fair Work (Registered Organisations) Regulations 2009*, is two months before the first day when a person may become a candidate. Since s.189(2) is a civil penalty provision and the prescribed information for this election was not lodged before the prescribed day, the Delegate of the General Manager has requested a written request for an extension of time and providing reasons why the prescribed information was not lodged before the prescribed day.
