# DECISION

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*Fair Work (Registered Organisations) Act 2009* s.189 – Arrangement for conduct of an election

Arrangement for conduct of election.

[1] On 14 December 2012 the Electrical, Energy and Services Division of the Communications, Electrical, Electronic, Energy, Information, Postal, Plumbing and Allied Services Union of Australia (the CEPU) lodged with Fair Work Australia prescribed information in relation to an election for the following offices:

Divisional President	(1)
Divisional Vice President	(2)

Divisional Executive Members: (numbers to be determined in accordance with the rules from the following Divisional Branches) New South Wales Queensland South Australia Tasmania Victoria Western Australia

[2] On 29 June 2012 I made arrangements for the conduct of an election by the Australian Electoral Commission in matter E2012/299 ([2012] FWAD 5149) for the same offices as listed above. I have, however, been advised by the Australian Electoral Commission that the election in E2012/299 did not proceed following an Order issued by his Honour Justice Jagot of the Federal Court of Australia on 29 June  $2012^{1}$  that the CEPU be restrained from convening and/or holding a meeting of the Divisional Council of the Electrical, Energy and Services Division.<sup>2</sup> The injunction was subsequently discharged by his Honour Justice Cowdroy on 26 November 2012.

[3] I am satisfied that an election for the abovenamed offices is required to be held under the rules of the organisation and, under subsection 189(3) of the *Fair Work (Registered Organisations)*
