I refer to the prescribed information dated 12 June 2013 which was lodged with the Fair Work Commission on 3 July 2013 for the conduct of a scheduled election for offices of the Electrical, Energy and Services Division of the Communications, Electrical, Electronic, Energy, Information, Postal, Plumbing and Allied Services Union of Australia.

Section 189(2) of the Fair Work (Registered Organisations) Act 2009 states that prescribed information must be lodged before the prescribed day, which under regulation 138(3) of the Fair Work (Registered Organisations) Regulations 2009, is two months before the first day when a person may become a candidate. Since s.189(2) is a civil penalty provision and the prescribed information for this election was not lodged before the prescribed day, the Delegate of the General Manager will require a written request for an extension of time and providing reasons why the prescribed information was not lodged before the prescribed day.
