Reminder of actions required when persons elected to office

The Australian Electoral Commission has provided the Fair Work Commission a copy of the declarations of results for the election E2016/242. The results were received today. This letter is a reminder of certain obligations imposed on organisations and persons elected to office.

Section 154D(1) of the Fair Work (Registered Organisations) Act 2009 (the RO Act) requires the rules of organisations (and branches of organisations) to require each officer with financial management duties to undertake approved training that covers those duties within 6 months after the person begins to hold office. Please ensure that relevant officers undertake approved training within the required timeframe and that all new holders of office are advised of their obligations to make disclosures regarding remuneration, non-cash benefits and material personal interests, the details of which should be provided for in your organisation's rules.

Section 233(2) of the RO Act requires that an organisation must notify the Commission of any changes to the records for the holders of office in the organisation. If the election has resulted in any changes to the holders of office, the organisation must notify the Commission of these changes. The notification must include a declaration by the Secretary (or other prescribed officer) that the information is a correct statement of the changes made.

If there have been no changes, a notification is not required.
