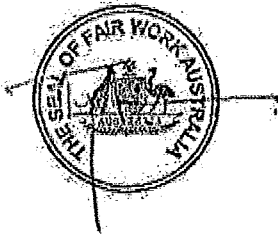

Following last night's meeting of the State Council of the NSW Divisional Branch of the Communications, Electrical, Electronic, Energy, Information, Postal, Plumbing and Allied Services Union of Australia - Electrical Division, I can confirm that the number of Divisional Branch Organisers to be elected at the upcoming NSW Divisional Branch Quadrennial Election will be 12.

A copy of the State Council resolution is attached as confirmation of the decision taken by the State Council.

In regards to the request in your most recent correspondence dated the 17th June 2011 for further information to determine the number of Divisional Branch Delegates to Divisional Council. I can confirm that in accordance with Rule 7.3.1 and 7.3.3 of the Electrical, Energy and Services Divisional Rules, the number of financial members of the NSW Divisional Branch as at today's date are 17,630 members.






