This is a courtesy letter to remind you of the financial reporting obligations of the abovenamed body under the *Workplace Relations Act 1996* ('the Act') for the financial year ended 31 March, 2003.

The legislative scheme set out in Part IX, Division 11 of the Act is directed at ensuring that a registered organisation or a branch of such an organisation discharges obligations of accountability to its members in relation to its financial affairs through proper and regular disclosure of financial information. The various steps of the financial reporting requirements must be carried out within the time-scales prescribed by the legislation so as to ensure the relevance of the financial information provided to the members.

Now that the financial year has ended, it is timely that you put in train the various steps of the financial reporting requirements. To assist you with this process I have enclosed for your information a notice summarising these requirements including the time-scales prescribed by the legislation.

Please note that a branch of an organisation may be exempted from the obligations arising under Part IX, Division 11 in respect of a financial year by satisfying a Registrar that the branch did not have any financial affairs during the financial year. An application under subsection 271A(1) of the Act must be made within 90 days (unless extended by a Registrar) after the end of the financial year.



NOTES TO AND FORMING PART OF THE ACCOUNTS AS AT 31 MARCH 2003

Note 1. STATEMENT OF ACCOUNTING POLICIES

The accounts have been prepared in accordance with Statements of Accounting Concepts, applicable Accounting Standards and the Corporations Law, including the disclosure requirements of Schedule 5. The accounts have been prepared on the basis of historical costs and do not take into account changing money values or, except where stated, current valuations of non-current assets. The accounting policies have been consistently applied, unless otherwise stated.

(a) Information to be provided to Members or Registrar.

In accordance with the requirements of the Workplace Relations Act 1996, as amended, members are drawn to the following provisions:

274(1) A member of an organisation, or a registrar, may apply to the organisation for the specified prescribed information in relation to the organisation.

274(2) An organisation shall, on application made under subsection (1) at the request of a member of the organisation concerned, and the registrar shall provide to a member information received because of an application made at the request of the member.

274(3) A Registrar may; only make an application under subsection (1) at the request of a member of the organisation concerned, and the Registrar shall provide to a member information received because of an application made at the request of the member.

(b) Property, Plant & Equipment

Property, plant and equipment are included at a cost or at independent or directors' valuation. The depreciable amount of all fixed assets including buildings and capitalised leased assets, but excluding freehold land, are depreciated over their useful lives commencing from the time the asset is held ready for use. Properties held for investment purposes are not subject to a depreciation charge. Leasehold improvements are amortised over the shorter of either the unexpired period of the lease or the estimated useful lives of the improvements.

(c) Employee Benefits

Contributions are made by the Union to an employee superannuation fund and are charged as expenses when incurred. The Union has no legal obligation to provide benefits to employees on retirement.

- (d) Superannuation the current figure has increased from the previous year due to:
 - (1) Salary sacrifice of \$200 per Week
 - (2) Normal superannuation calculated at 9% of gross income.
- (e) Current Loss has been funded by the sale of assets as reflected in the balance sheet.

Re: Financial Statements for Communications, Electrical, Electronic, Energy, Information, Postal, Plumbing and Allied Services Union of Australia - Plumbing Division - Australian Capital Territory Branch - for the year ended 31 March 2003 (FR2003/46)

I refer to our discussion by phone this morning in relation to the above financial statements which were lodged in the Registry on 7 August 2003 and acknowledge receipt of the copy of the notice of a special general meeting given for the purpose of ratification of the audited accounts by the members.

I would like to take this opportunity to comment on two items arising from the financial return.

Firstly, the dating of the statements does not correspond to the sequence that is contemplated by the *Workplace Relations Act 1996*. For example, although a letter signed by Keith Knight confirming the completion of the audit is dated 6 June 2003, the Auditor's report that was lodged appears to be dated 30 July 2003 which is later that the meeting held on the 24th July to ratify and adopt the audit. It is also later than the Accounting Officer's certificate and the Committee of Management Certificate which are both dated 26 June 2003.

The Registry would expect that the Auditor's report lodged would be dated on or after the date on the certificates, and that all three would be signed and dated before any meetings held to ratify or adopt the report and statements. This is more than just a technical point as the signed report and statements are documents which the Act envisages are provided to members.

Secondly, I note your advice that the special general meeting called for the 24th July failed through lack of a quorum, but that the financial statements and affairs of the branch were discussed at other meetings of members called primarily to report on enterprise bargaining issues and that these meetings were well attended with attendances of up to, or in excess of, 90 members. I also note your advice that

members had access to the financial statements through union officers attending workplaces.

As I indicated, the Registry takes the view that in order to comply with the requirement of \$279 of the Act to "provide...to members...copies...of the accounts and statements" organisations and their branches must take steps that will reasonably ensure the members are able to consider the financial statements. Where attendance at general members' meetings is poor, it is common for organisations and branches to either (1) post a copy or summary to each member, or (2) post copies or summaries to members at their workplaces for distribution, or (3) publish the statements in full or in summary form in a journal or newsletter that is made available widely to members.

After careful consideration, the documents for the year ending 31 March 2003 will be filed. However I would recommend that you consider what the branch needs to, and can reasonably, do to meet the requirements of the legislation in this important area, for future financial returns.
