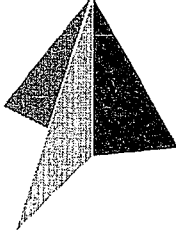


STATUTORY DECLARATION


