Notes:

- The Elections in New South Wales (NSW) and the Australian Capital territory Sub-Branch could not be held on the dates above as there were rule changes that were going through the approval process. The rules have now been approved therefore the elections can now take place.

Rule 49.4

Nominations shall be called for by advertisement in a daily newspaper circulating in the State or Territory in which the Branch is situated. Nominations must open no later than the last Monday in March in each election year. The closing date for nominations shall be the last Monday in April, 1995 and in each fourth year thereafter. Provided that any nomination may be withdrawn upon written notice of the nominee delivered to the Returning Officer within two weeks of the close of nominations.


