DECISION

Fair Work (Registered Organisations) Act 2009 s.189—Arrangement for conduct of an election

Communications, Electrical, Electronic, Energy, Information, Postal, Plumbing and Allied Services Union of Australia (E2015/103)

Arrangement for conduct of election.

- [1] On 11 March 2015 the ACT Sub-Branch of the NSW Divisional Branch of the Plumbing Division of the Communications, Electrical, Electronic, Energy, Information, Postal, Plumbing and Allied Services Union of Australia (the organisation) lodged with the Fair Work Commission (the Commission) the prescribed information in relation to an election.
- [2] On 18 March 2015 the organisation lodged further and amended prescribed information. The further amended prescribed information was an amended resolution to verify the number of Sub-Branch Trustees and Sub-Branch Committee of Management Members required, in accordance with the relevant rules. The further and amended prescribed information is in relation to an election for the following offices:

Sub-Branch President	(1)
Sub-Branch Secretary	(1)
Sub-Branch Trustee	(1)
Sub-Branch Committee of Management Member	(3)

- [3] The prescribed information was not lodged before the prescribed day as required by section 189(2) of the Fair Work (Registered Organisations) Act 2009 (the Act).
- [4] On 11 March 2015, Mr Earl Setches, the Divisional Secretary of the Plumbing Division of the CEPU (the Division), provided a request for an extension of time for lodgement of the prescribed information. The request provides that the delay in lodgement arose due to a misunderstanding of the definition of "prescribed day" as set out in regulation 138(3) of the Fair Work (Registered Organisations) Regulations 2009. Mr Setches further notes that the various pieces of prescribed information for the last quadrennial elections for offices of the Division and its branches and sub-branches were also lodged in 2011 about the same time according to that previous misunderstanding.

- [5] Rule 49.4 of the rules of the Division provides that nominations "must open no later than the last Monday in March in each election year". Therefore, according to the rules of the Division, the first day when a person may become a candidate in the election is 30 March 2015 at the latest. Given this, the prescribed information was required to be lodged before 30 January 2015.
- With regard to the request for an extension of time for lodgement of the prescribed information, I have considered the explanation for the delay in lodging the prescribed information provided by Mr Setches. Having regard to the normal and reasonable expectation that registered organisations take steps to ensure that they comply with the time-frame requirements set out not only in the Act but also in instruments or references pertaining to their own governance formulated by organisations themselves, I decline on this occasion to allow, in the formal sense intended by section 189(2) of the Act, a later day for lodgement. The failure of the organisation to lodge the prescribed information before the prescribed day contravenes section 189(2) of the Act which is a civil penalty provision. Failures by organisations to comply with civil penalty provisions may be the subject of applications by the Fair Work Commission for orders in the Federal Court.
- [7] The refusal of an extension of time under section 189(2) of the Act does not, however, affect a determination of an election notification matter for the purposes of section 189(3) of the Act.
- [8] I am satisfied that an election for the abovenamed offices is required to be held under the rules of the organisation and, under subsection 189(3) of the Fair Work (Registered Organisations) Act 2009, I am making arrangements for the conduct of the election by the Australian Electoral Commission.

Dear General Manager.

The CEPU Plumbing has lodged various election prescribed notices in relation to upcoming elections. These notices were lodged (emailed) to your department last Friday March 6th.

It has been pointed out that these lodgements have been lodged late as per Regulation 138(3) of the Registered Organisation Rules of the Fair Work Act.

As these lodgements were late the CEPU Plumbing would like to request an extension of time for the following reasons.

As per the above regulation, the CEPU has taken the meaning of this regulation as follows

The regulation states that the prescribed day to be 2 months before the day a person may, under the rules of the organisation or branch, become a candidate for an election.

The CEPU took this to mean a person cannot become a candidate until an election is called by the AEC and not when nominations are open as per your correspondence.

In 2011, our prescribed notices were lodged about the same time as our current notices so we were of the understanding this was acceptable.

Reason for Election:

Election for offices and positions marked "A" respectively is required as the terms of office are due to expire in the normal course of events under the rules of the organisation.

Elected By:

The electorate for the voting system is the whole of the Branch.

Nominations Open:

For the offices to elected by direct voting system – the last Monday in March

Nominations Close:

For the offices to elected by direct voting system - the last Monday in April

Cut-off Date for Roll:

In all cases – 7 days prior to the opening date for nominations – Rule 49.9 (see note below)

Notes:

Given that the last Monday in April is a Public Holiday and there are a total of 3 Public Holidays in the nomination period it may be necessary to change the date of nominations closing to the last Friday in April. If the date is to change the actual clasing date will not be in accordance with the CEPU Plumbing Rules. (Rule 49.9).

Rule 49.4

Nominations shall be called for by advertisement in a daily newspaper circulating in the State or Territory in which the Branch is situated. Nominations must open no later than the last Monday in March in each election year. The closing date for nominations shall be the last Monday in April, 1995 and in each fourth year thereafter. Provided that any nomination may be withdrawn upon written notice of the nominee delivered to the Returning Officer within two weeks of the close of nominations.
