- Rule 29.1 states the Returning Officer shall be a financial member of the division. This needs to be amended as the AEC regularly conducts the elections on behalf of the CEPU.
- Rule 49.4 allows 2 weeks for nominees to withdraw their nomination after the
 nominations have closed with rule 49.5 stating the Returning Officer can
 declare the election if no more nominations for election to any office are
 received than the number of vacancies for such office. This could create a
 situation where the position becomes vacant unless the rule states the
 Returning Officer us unable to declare until after the withdrawal period closes.
