The electorate for the elections is the existing delegates to all divisional conferences of the Divisions of the Union.


Voting System

The election is to be conducted under a collegiate electoral system.

You will note that it is proposed that the opening of nominations for the positions to be elected is at a time less than the period prescribed in Regulation 138(3). This has occurred substantially because it has been necessary to await the certification of amendments to Rule 16 of the National Rules of the Union before calling the elections. Those amendments were certified on Tuesday 13 June 2006. I would ask that you exercise the discretion allowed in Section 189(2) of the RAO Schedule by accepting the lodgement of the information set out above despite the requirements set out in Regulation 138(3).
