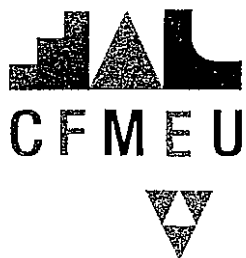


### **Electorate/Voting System**
