





- (c) **Where more than one of the offices in respect of which an election is required has the same name and the number of such offices can, in accordance with the rules of the relevant organisation or branch, be ascertained before the prescribed day – the number of these offices:**

- (d) **Where the electorate comprises only members of a branch, section or other division of an organisation – the name of that branch, section or division:**

The Branch officers referred to herein are elected by and from the State Conference of each of the respective Branches.

- (e) **The date and time of the commencement and expiration of the period during which nominations of candidates will be called for or may be made under the rules:**

Rule 48(1) of the rules of the CFMEU provides, inter alia, that the election shall be held, the necessary changes being made, in the same way as Divisional Officers are elected from the Divisional Conference under Rule 9 of the Construction & General Division Rules.

Rule 9 5. of the Construction and General Division Rules relevantly provides that nominations shall be called for by the Returning Officer on a date fixed by the Returning Officer following the fixing by Divisional Executive pursuant to sub-rule 8(xi) of a date and place for the holding of elections required under the rule and shall close fourteen days after nominations are called.

- (f) **The voting system to be employed in the conduct of the election:**

A collegiate electoral system is to be employed in the election, the relevant college being those persons elected as members of the State Conference of the respective Branches.

Other Matters

Rule 48(1) of the rules of the CFMEU provides, inter alia, that each Division shall hold at least one position of Joint Vice-President and that each Division, prior to the calling for nominations, shall decide its nominees for the above positions, by resolution from that Division's Divisional Branch Management Committee.
