RE: Fair Work (Registered Organisations) Act 2009 Section 271 - Construction, Forestry, Maritime, Mining and Energy Union - Australian Capital Territory Branch - Application for Exemption Certificate for year ending 31 December 2020

I am the Secretary of the Construction, Forestry, Maritime, Mining and Energy Union - Australian Capital Territory Branch (the ACT Branch) and occupied that position for the financial year ending 31 December 2020.

I am authorised under the rules to act on behalf of the Branch.

Pursuant to section 271 of the Fair Work (Registered Organisations) Act 2009 (the Act), I hereby apply for a certificate of exemption for the ACT Branch in respect of the financial year ending 31 December 2020.

In support of this application I submit as follows:

- 1. The Construction, Forestry, Maritime, Mining and Energy Union (CFMMEU) consists of four Divisions organised by industries. Within these four Divisions are Divisional Branches or District Branches.
- 2. Such Divisional (or District) Branches function within a designated geographical area, in most cases being the State or Territory in which they are established.
- 3. The CFMMEU and each Division and Divisional (or District) Branch thereof submit annual financial returns in accordance with the Act.
- 4. CFMMEU State Branches, including the ACT Branch, consist of the members and officers of each Divisional (or District) Branch in each State or Territory.
- 5. The ACT Branch has not had an account with a bank or any other financial institution nor has it had custody of any real property or monies during the financial year.
- 6. The ACT Branch had no reason to keep accounting records and did not have any financial affairs during the financial year.

- 7. The ACT Branch has not traded or carried out financial transactions of any kind and has not expended economic resources or incurred any financial obligations to conduct its activities during the financial year.
- 8. The ACT Branch does not expend its own economic resources or incur financial obligations so to conduct its activities.
- 9. No person or body corporate or trust expends its own economic resources or incurs financial obligations so that the ACT Branch may conduct its activities.
- 10. Another reporting unit of the CFMMEU, the CFMMEU, Construction & General Division, ACT Divisional Branch, expends its own economic resources and/or incurs financial obligations so the ACT Branch can conduct its activities.
- 11. Notwithstanding the above, the ACT Branch has functioned in accordance with the rules of the CFMMEU including the rules relating to Branches.
