**Divisional Branch Elections (E2004/185)**

I understand you have been formally appointed Acting National Secretary of the Division during Mr Trevor Smith's absence. As you are aware, Mr Smith lodged prescribed information in the Registry on 4 May 2004 and amended information on 11 and 19 May 2004 for elections for various offices in the Division's branches and for the election of delegates from those branches to the Divisional Conference.

I have considered the information lodged and the Federal and Divisional rules of the union. As explained below, before determining this matter I will require additional information. I also seek your comments or submissions on various matters.

**Prescribed Information**

I will refer to prescribed information lodged for the Division's branches as described in the schedules attached to Mr Smith's correspondence.

**1. Schedule C - Victorian FFTS**

The prescribed information states that an election is required for the following offices of the FFTS Victorian Branch:

Branch President  
Vice President (Senior)  
Vice President  
Vice President (AA)  
Secretary  
Assistant Secretary  
Trustee (4 - of which one is an affirmative action position)  
Committee Members (10 - of whom two are affirmative action positions)

The offices listed above correspond to those established and provided for in rule 41 of the FFPD Division's rules and comprise the "management committee" of a "Divisional Branch" of the Division.

My preliminary view, however is that the offices of the "FFTS Victorian Branch" (as it is called in sub-rule 42D (3) of the CFMEU Federal rules) and for which any election may be required, are the offices which reflect the "current structure" of the FFTS Victorian Branch as described in rule 42D of the Federal rules.

## Meaning and Effect of Rule 42D

Sub-rules 42D (1) and (2) appear to reflect the intended timetable for restructuring of the FFTS Division, including in sub-rule 42D(2)(c) "The continued operation" of the Victorian Branch of the FFTS Division "within the restructured Division of up to four years...". This four-year period expires on 26 March 2005.

Sub-rule 42D(3) reinforces the continued operation of the FFTS Victorian Branch by providing that it "shall unless otherwise agreed by the FFTS Branch Management Committee maintain its current structure and existence with the restructured Division up until 26 March 2005".

Sub-rules 42D(4) and (5) provide for a process to "finalise translation/integration" by agreement and in the absence of agreement, by reference to the "CFMEU National Executive".

Sub-rule 42D(6)(d)(a) describes the manner "until the elections scheduled to be held in August 2004" the FFTS Victorian Branch "shall be constituted and represented."

The rules of the union do not reflect that the integration process has been finally concluded in the manner sub-rules 42D(4) and (5) contemplate or otherwise. Therefore, it appears that the Victorian FFTS Branch "structure and existence" continue in their current form. However, if the FFTS Victorian Branch Management Committee has agreed to no longer maintain "its current structure and existence" I would appreciate copies of any resolutions reflecting that decision.

If so, my preliminary view is that such agreement would then need to be reflected in further alterations to the rules of the union.

### Current Offices of FFTS Victorian Branch

As noted above, sub-rule 42D(6)(d)(a) lists the offices which constitute the management committee of the FFTS Victorian Branch. I will describe those offices as follows:

Branch President  
Vice Presidents (2)  
Branch Secretary  
Assistant Branch Secretary  
Trustees (3)  
Committee Members (11)

In my view, it is reasonable to conclude that the "current structure" of the FFTS Victorian Branch is that set out in sub-rule 42D(6)(d)(a) and that while the Branch maintains "its current structure and existence within the restructured Division" those offices are subject to election at the forthcoming quadrennial Divisional Branch elections.

I would appreciate your comments or any submission you may wish to make in response. If you agree with my view, amended prescribed information in relation to Schedule C should be lodged as soon as possible.

## **2. Schedule A - New South Wales Divisional Branch**

The list of offices in the amended prescribed information for this Branch is as follows:

Branch President (Honorary)  
Branch President (Employed)  
Vice President (Senior)  
Vice President (Junior)  
Vice President (Junior)(AA)  
Trustee (3)  
Trustee (AA) (2)  
Committee Member (8)  
Committee Member (2)(AA)

As previously noted, rule 41 of the Division's rules provides for the offices of each Divisional Branch. Special provision is made for the NSW Branch where rule 41 provides there "shall be an additional President (full time) and one (1) additional Trustee".

## Trustees

The prescribed information lists four offices of Trustee for which an election is required. Two of these offices are described as "AA" or affirmative action positions. It would appear however that the rules make no provision for the "additional Trustee" to be an affirmative action position. Subject to any comments you may wish to make, I propose to provide for only one of the four Trustee offices to be an "affirmative action" position.

### **3. Schedules G and H - Western Australia and Queensland Divisional Branches**

#### Implications of affirmative action requirements

These Branches are seeking elections be conducted to fill the following number of "other member" positions on their Branch Committees of Management:

- Western Australia - five positions of which one is an "affirmative action" position.
- Queensland - three positions of which none is an "affirmative action" position

Rule 41 gives Branches discretion to determine that "not more than ten (10) other members - *two of which will be designated affirmative action positions*" be elected to the committee of management (*my emphasis*).

This rule would appear to require that two of the ten or fewer members so determined be "affirmative action" positions. If so, this would require that two of the five positions specified for the Western Australian Branch and two of the three positions sought in Queensland be subject to affirmative action.

Please provide any comments or submissions you may wish to make on the interpretation or application of this part of Rule 41; or if the Division accepts my preliminary interpretation of the rules and wishes to lodge amending prescribed information increasing the number of committee members to take into account the affirmative action positions, please do so.

### **4. Schedule D - No. 7 Branch and Sub-branches**

#### Delegates to Divisional Branch Management Committee

The amended prescribed information states that the Burnie, Maryvale, Melbourne, Millicent, Nowra and Sydney sub-branches are entitled to an additional delegate or delegates, as specified, to the Divisional Branch Management Committee.

Sub-rule 72(8) of the Division's rules provides that the Secretary of each sub-branch is the delegate to the Divisional Branch Management Committee. The sub-rule then provides a procedure based on membership numbers by which the entitlement of branches to "additional Delegates" is determined.

The prescribed information does not include information on the number of members of each sub-branch by which the entitlement to and the requirement for an election of "additional Delegates" can be determined.

Please provide membership figures for all sub-branches to enable the respective branches' entitlements to be ascertained.

### **5. Divisional Conference Delegates**

Each of the Schedules originally lodged setting out the prescribed information for each Branch included provision for the election of one or more "delegates to Divisional Conference". I note from

Mr Smith's letter of 12 May 2004 and the amended Schedule H for the Queensland Branch that it is now considered the Branch's membership numbers do not entitle it to a delegate other than the Branch Secretary by virtue of office.

### Calculation of Delegate Entitlement

Rule 8 establishes the Divisional Conference as the Division's Supreme Governing Body. Sub-rule 8(iii) provides for Divisional Branch representation as follows:

- (iii) Each Divisional Branch shall be entitled to one (1) representative up to 500 members, one (1) additional representative between 500 members and 1,000 members and one representative for each additional 1,000 members, based on the aggregate income received by each Divisional Branch (union contributions only) divided by the amount of the yearly contribution fixed by the rules from time to time, for the financial year ending on the 31st December in the year preceding the quadrennial election of representatives to act as its representatives at the Divisional Conference.

The Divisional Branch Secretary of each Branch shall, ipso facto, be one of that Branch's representatives to the Divisional Conference. The number of representatives to which each Divisional Branch is entitled shall remain unaltered throughout the period between the quadrennial elections.

In effect this sub-rule provides for the application of a formula based on each Branch's membership contributions to determine the number of representatives or delegates to which a Branch is entitled.

The prescribed information does not however include information from which the number of representatives or delegates required to be elected can be determined.

To assist me determine this matter, please:

- specify the aggregate income received (union contributions only) for each branch and the yearly contribution fixed by the rules from time to time which were applied to determine the number of representatives to which it is considered each branch is entitled.
- provide a copy of your working of this formula for each branch

### Branch Secretary

I note that sub-rule 8(ii) includes a proviso that "Divisional Branch Secretaries by virtue of being elected as such shall automatically be the Divisional Branch delegate or one of the Divisional Branch delegates to Divisional Conference".

From my examination of prescribed information and correspondence relating to the Division's quadrennial elections for the Divisional Conference delegate positions in 2000, it is important to distinguish between the number of Branch delegates required to be elected by the members and the number of delegates who will be entitled to represent the Branch at the Conference. The former figure should be reflected in the prescribed information lodged.

The following table summarises the provisions sub-rules 8(ii) and (iii) as they appear to apply to this entitlement.

### *Divisional Conference - Representatives/Delegates*

No. of Members as determined by rules	No. of Delegates to be elected by members	No. of delegates representing Branch (includes Secretary)
0 - 500	0	1
501 - 1000	1	2
1000- 2000	2	3
2000 - 3000	3	4
3000 - 4000	4	5
4000 - 5000	5	6



## Increased Divisional Branch Entitlement

Sub-rule 8(viii) includes a proviso that "Branch entitlement to delegates [to Divisional Conference] shall be increased by the number of full-time Divisional Officers nominating as Divisional Conference delegates in that Divisional Branch...". The sub-rule requires Divisional Officers (as defined) who wish to nominate to notify their intention to the Divisional Branch Secretary "prior to the date of calling of nominations".

It is therefore not possible to state with certainty the number of Divisional Conference delegate positions for which the Returning Officer will be required to call for nominations until prior to that date.

I would appreciate your advice on how your organisation applies this rule in practice.

At this stage I would propose to alert the Returning Officer to this provision by incorporating the relevant text of this sub-rule in my decision.
