**DECISION**

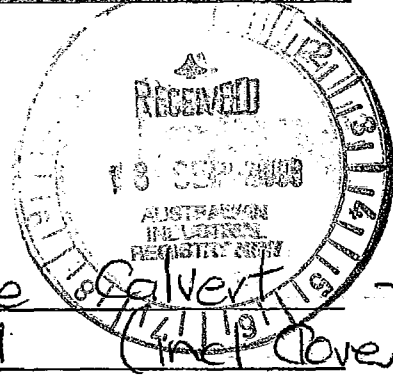

**CFMEU FFPD application for quadrennial elections**

On Friday 29<sup>th</sup> August 2008 we sent an application and on the 1<sup>st</sup> September a variation, for the calling of nominations for several offices/positions.

On 12<sup>th</sup> September you wrote to us with a number of questions.

We have attached amended Schedules to our request for the calling of nominations and have also attached a request for election for an organiser position to be conducted at the same time.

In response to your correspondence we provide the following information.

1. The calculations for delegates to Divisional Conference are based on the aggregate income received by each Divisional Branch (union contributions only) divided by the amount of the yearly contribution.
  - No. 1 Divisional Branch figure is 11,868, which was calculated using the audited figures from the most recently lodged GPFS for each of the former Divisional Branches that now make up the No 1 Divisional Branch. Based on this there is an entitlement to 12 delegates, 6 of which will, ex officio, be filled by the No 1 Divisional Branch Secretary and the Secretaries from the Districts. Thus there is a requirement for 6 further delegates to be elected.
  - No. 2 Divisional Branch figure is 5013. Based on this there is an entitlement to 6 delegates, 1 of whom will, ex officio, be filled by the No. 2 Divisional Branch Secretary. Thus there is a requirement for 5 further delegates to be elected. We have attached an amended Schedule C to clarify the request for No. 2 Divisional Branch Delegates to Divisional Conference.
2. In the No. 2 Divisional Branch there will be 6 Committee of Management members (including one affirmative action position). This is in accordance with the Rule 33 (ii) which allows "no more than ten". We read rule 58 (v) as meaning up to ten other members.
3. We have attached a separate request for the election of an Organiser in the No. 2 Divisional Branch.

4. We have attached amended Schedules D, E and G to clarify the requests for Vice Presidents of the No.1 Divisional Branch NSW, Tasmania and Victoria Districts.

5. The number of Committee of Management members for each District is at the discretion of the District Management Committee. The numbers have been determined by the current Divisional Branches Committees of Management and are set between the minimum and maximum number pursuant to Rule 42 (i) which states that:

- a District must have a President, Secretary, a Vice President and no less than three COM members; a minimum of 6
- a District may have up to two further Vice Presidents (and one must be an affirmative action position), an Assistant Secretary and no more than 14 COM members (and two must be affirmative action positions); a maximum of 20.

In the 2008 Rules there is no requirement for consistency between the Districts in the determination of numbers and/or affirmative action positions for the NSW, Vic, SA, Tas Districts of No 1 Divisional Branch.

We believe that the current request is in accordance with the Rules.

I refer to the prescribed information lodged in the Industrial Registry on 1 September 2008 and amended on the same day. There are a number of issues on which I require further information or clarification in order to be able to finalise the decision for the conduct of the election. I have set these out below in numbered points for ease of reference:

1. Please provide the calculations for the basis on which the number of delegates to Divisional Conference from the No 1 and No 2 Branches have been calculated [ie the figures for the formula in accordance with rule 8(iii)].
2. The number of Committee of Management members in the No 2 Branch is specified as 6 (including one designated affirmative action). Rule 58(v) prescribes ten (including two designated affirmative action). In contrast rule 33(ii) prescribes "not more than ten (10)". Please clarify the Division's view of this and confirm the number.
3. The "Organiser" in the No 2 Branch is not an "office" as defined in the RAO Schedule and the Division must specifically request that an election for positions be conducted at the same time as the election for offices in order for me to include any positions in the decision [see s.187 of RAO Schedule for the requirements].
4. I have not been able to identify in the rules the office of Vice President (Senior) which has been requested for the New South Wales, Victorian and Tasmanian Districts of the No 1 Branch. The rules provide for up to two additional Vice Presidents but do not as far as I can tell establish a "Senior" Vice President.
5. Please provide the basis on which the number of Committee of Management members and the proportion of designated affirmative action positions has been determined in the New South Wales, Victorian, South Australian and Tasmanian Districts of No 1 Branch. I note that there does not appear to be consistency in the proportions of affirmative action positions across the Districts.
6. Please provide the figures for the basis on which the number of delegates to District Committee of Management in the Pulp & Paper Workers Sub Branches have been calculated [ie the number of members in accordance with rule 57(8)].
7. The second Vice President office in the Pulp & Paper Workers Sub Branches should include the term "Junior" in the title in accordance with rule 57(18)(a).

Please do not hesitate to contact me to clarify any of the above issues I have raised. Once the above information has been provided and if necessary any amending prescribed information has been lodged I am confident that my decision can be issued quickly.


