If a website is not available, publishing a notice in a journal or newsletter would be considered appropriate.

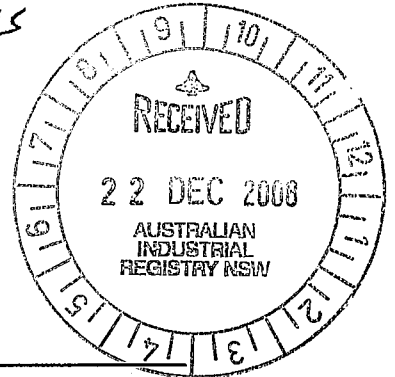

Nominations open on at 9.30 am on Wednesday 18th February 2009 and nominations close at 9.45 am on Wednesday 18th February 2009.


Ballot
