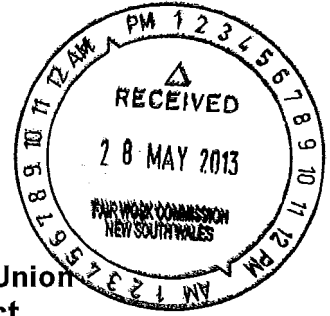

Section 197(1) of Schedule 1 of the Fair Work (Registered Organisations) Act 2009 requires the AEC to provide a written report on the conduct of the election to Fair Work Australia and to the organisation or branch for whom the election was conducted. If a website is not available, publishing a notice in a journal or newsletter would be considered appropriate.

Arrangement for conduct of election.

[1] On 21 December 2012, the Forestry, Furnishing, Building Products and Manufacturing Division of the Construction, Forestry, Mining and Energy Union lodged with the Fair Work Commission the prescribed information in relation to an election for the following offices:

Pulp and Paper Workers' District

District President	(1)
Senior District Vice President	(1)
Junior District Vice President	(1)
Trustee	(3)

[2] On 4 January 2013, the Fair Work Commission wrote to the organisation to draw its attention to the fact that as the prescribed information had not been lodged before the prescribed day in accordance with section 189(2) of the *Fair Work (Registered Organisations) Act 2009* (the Act), a request for an extension of time would be required providing a reason why the prescribed information was not lodged on time.

[3] On 4 January 2013, the organisation lodged a request for an extension of time under section 189(2) of the Act to lodge the prescribed information on 21 December 2012. The organisation submitted that the lodgement of the prescribed information had been delayed due to recent administrative burdens and an oversight on its behalf.

[4] I am satisfied that an election for the offices referred to in paragraph [1] is required to be held under the rules of the organisation and, under subsection 189(3) of the Act, I am making arrangements for the conduct of the election by the Australian Electoral Commission.

RE: E2012/432 and E2012/433 - Forestry, Furnishing, Building Products and Manufacturing Division (FFPD) – Collegiate Elections for Divisional Positions and PPW District Positions

I refer to correspondence with today's date addressed to our National Secretary Michael O'Connor, in relation to the above matters which relate to the conduct of collegiate elections for various positions within the Division. In that correspondence the Union is requested to seek an extension of the time required for the lodgement of the prescribed information required in relation to the conduct of those elections, and to provide reasons for the delay in lodgement of the prescribed information.

In each case the prescribed information was not able to be lodged before the prescribed day as the dates for the relevant meetings were only confirmed in late December 2012. In the circumstances, the applications were lodged as expeditiously as was administratively possible, bearing in mind the Union's resources, after the confirmation of the relevant meeting dates. The dates for these meetings were not able to be confirmed earlier as our internal resources were allocated to making arrangements to deal with the administrative changes which will flow from the amendments to our rules in R2012/115 and R2012/116, which came into effect on 2 January 2013. Finally, in relation to E2012/433 in particular, an administrative oversight meant that the Union did not turn its attention to the need file the prescribed information prior to 21 December 2012.

The Union requests that the Commission extend the time required in relation to both matters. We note that the extension required in each case is relatively short, a matter of one day in the case of E2012/432 and ten days in the case of E2012/433 and submit that no administrative difficulty or prejudice reasonably arises as a result of such short delays.

Arrangements for the conduct of an Election (E2012/432, E2012/433)

I refer to the prescribed information dated 21 December 2012 which was lodged with the Fair Work Commission (previously called Fair Work Australia) on 21 December 2012 for the conduct of scheduled elections for offices of the Forestry, Furnishing, Building Products and Manufacturing Division (FFPD) of the Construction, Forestry, Mining and Energy Union (CFMEU) and the Pulp and Paper Workers' District of the FFPD of the CFMEU.

Section 189(2) of the *Fair Work (Registered Organisations) Act 2009* (the Act) states that the prescribed information must be lodged before the prescribed day, which, under regulation 138(3) of the *Fair Work (Registered Organisations) Regulations 2009*, is two months before the first day when a person may become a candidate.

The prescribed information lodged pertaining to the election of offices within the Divisional Executive of the FFPD (E2012/432) indicates that Divisional Conference of the FFPD will occur from 19-20 February 2013. Rule 9(iv) of the rules of the FFPD and the prescribed information provide that nominations for these offices will be called for on the second day of the Divisional Conference, in this case, 20 February 2012. Therefore, pursuant to the Act, the prescribed information in relation to this election was required to be lodged before 20 December 2012.

The prescribed information lodged pertaining to the election of offices within the Pulp and Paper Workers' District of the FFPD (E2012/433) indicates that the relevant District Management Committee meeting will occur on 12 February 2013. Rule 42(11) of the rules of the FFPD and the prescribed information provide that nominations will be called for these offices during the relevant meeting of the District Management Committee. Therefore, pursuant to the Act, the prescribed information in relation to this election was required to be lodged before 12 December 2012.

Since section 189(2) of the Act is a civil remedy provision and the prescribed information in relation to both elections was not lodged before the prescribed day, the Fair Work Commission requests that your organisation lodge a written request for an extension of time to lodge the prescribed information after the prescribed day and provide brief reasons why the prescribed information was not lodged before the prescribed day for both election matters.
