Prescribed Information in Respect of Election

Regulation 138 – Workplace Relations (Registration and Accountability of Organisations) Regulations.

The following prescribed information is provided pursuant to Regulation 138 of the Workplace Relations (Registration and Accountability of Organisations) Regulations:

- (a) The name of each office in respect of which an election is required;
 - (i) One (1) ACT Divisional Branch Northern Territory delegate to Divisional Conference of the Construction and General Division of the CFMEU.
- (b) The reason for the election;

A new office has been created -- see Divisional rule 8(viA) certified 23 December, 2005 R No. 2005/234.

(c) Where more than one of the offices in respect of which an election is required has the same name and the number of such offices can, in accordance with the rules of the relevant organization or branch, be ascertained before the prescribed day—the number of these offices;

Not applicable.

(d) Where the electorate comprises only members of a branch, section or other division of an organization -- the name of that branch, section or division;

The officer referred to herein is elected by and from all members of the Australian Capital Territory Divisional Branch who are residing or employed in the Northern Territory.

(e) The date and time of the commencement and expiration of the period during which nominations of candidates will be called for or may be made under the rules;

As the election is required as a result of the creation of a new office, the rules do not explicitly provide for a nomination period in respect of such office. However Rule 38 of the Construction and General Division Rules relevantly provides that nominations shall be called for by the Returning Officer on or before the last day of August and shall close on the second last Friday of September i.e. a period of approximately 3 weeks.

(f) The day provided for in the rules of the organisation as the day on which the roll of voters is to be closed;

Rule 38(p) provides that the books of the Divisional Branches shall be deemed to have closed eight (8) days before the date on which nominations open.

(g) The voting system to be employed in the conduct of the election;

A direct electoral system is to be employed in the election, the relevant electorate being those members of the Australian Capital Territory Divisional Branch who are residing or employed in the Northern Territory.
