I refer to your facsimile letter dated 4 September 2008 concerning the "notice issued by the AEC calling for nominations" with respect to the abovementioned election within the Western Australia Divisional Branch. I note the views you have expressed with respect to the offices of Divisional Branch Vice President and Divisional Branch Trustee within the Western Australia Divisional Branch.




