Salary: Salary levels are reviewed by the BOM with any changes taking effect from 1 July. The applicable base salary for all full time Officials for the 2019 financial year was \$201,847. Salary amounts also include annual leave (including leave loading), sick leave and long service leave taken.

Travel Allowances: This includes Domestic Travel (an \$85 overnight allowance is paid) and International Travel (applicable allowances are paid in accordance with the ATO issued reasonable allowances).

Other Income: Can include items such as cash out of sick leave or annual leave entitlements or payment of overnight allowance when attending Central Council.

Termination Payments: Include payments of unused employee entitlements and any applicable redundancy payments.

Reportable Fringe Benefits: These include non cash benefits provided to Officials, where FBT is applicable. Each Full time Official is provided with a fully maintained motor vehicle.
