In accordance with the above-mentioned provisions of the Workplace Relations Act 1996, we submit the following information in relation to the election of officers of our NSW Branch.



2. Reason for election:
 - The term of Office of the current office-holders expires at the forthcoming State Conference.
 3. Offices with the same name:
 - See 1. above
 4. Electorate:
 - The electorate consists of delegates to the State Conference (see Rule 46)
 5. Period of nomination:
 - Rule 48 makes reference to Rule 9 of the Construction & General Divisional Rules, as being the basis upon which State Officers are to be elected, the necessary changes being made. Further Rule 9(5) of the C&G Div Rules provides for a 14-day nomination period from the last Friday in September.
As this time has passed it may be appropriate to alter and shorten the nomination period. We suggest that nominations open on Friday 16th November and close mid-day Friday 23rd November 2001.
 6. Voting System:
 - A collegiate voting system is to be employed in the conduct of the election in accordance with Rule 48(i).

We regret that the above information has not been lodged on or before the prescribed day as referred to in Regulation 61(3) and we respectfully request that an extension of time be granted in this respect pursuant to Regulation 135(1)(e).


