FAIR WORK (REGISTERED ORGANISATIONS) REGULATIONS 2009

Prescribed Information in Respect of Election

Regulation 138 Fair Work (Registered Organisations)Regulations

The following prescribed information is provided pursuant to Regulation 138 of the Fair Work (Registeded Organisations) Regulation:

a. The name of each office in respect of which an election is required:

i.	One (1)	State President
ii.	One (1)	State Secretary
ili.	One (1)	State Assistant Secretary
lv.	One (1)	State Senior Vice-President
٧.	Three (3)	State Joint Vice-President

b. The reason for the election:

Expiry of the term of office of each of the current office holders.

c. Where more than one of the offices in respect of which an election is required has the same name and the number of such offices can, in accordance with the rules of the relevant organisation or branch, be ascertained before the prescribed day – the number of these offices.

d. Where the electorate comprises only members of a branch, section or other division of an organisation – the name of that branch, section or division:

The officers referred to herein are elected by and from State Conference of the New South Wales Branch of the CFMEU.

e. The date and time of the commencement and expiration of the period during which nominations of candidates will be called for or may be made under the rules:

Rule 48(i) of the rules of the CFMEU relevantly provide that the election of state officers shall be held, the necessary changes being made, in the same way as Divisional Officers are elected from the Divisional Conference under Rule 9 of the Construction and General Division Rules.

Rule 9.5 of the Construction and General Divisional Rules relevantly provides that nominations shall be called for by the Returning Officer on a date fixed by the Returning Officer following the fixing by Divisional Executive pursuant to sub-rule 8(xi) of a date and place for the holding of elections required under this rule and shall close fourteen days after nominations are called.

f. The voting system to be employed in the conduct of the election:

A collegiate electoral system is to be employed in the election, the relevant college being those persons elected as Divisional Branch Management Committee members of every Divisional Branch of the CFMEU in the state of NSW.
