Could you please advise me when you expect to be able to lodge the financial documents?



We have audited the financial statements of Construction Forestry Mining & Energy Union – Albury Sub Branch for the year ended 31st December, 2003 as shown in the Profit & Loss Statement, and Bank Reconciliation. The Treasurer is responsible for the preparation and presentation of the financial statements and the presentation of the information contained therein. We have conducted an independent audit of the financial statements in order to express an opinion on them to the members.

Jur audit has been conducted in accordance with Australian Auditing Standards to provide reasonable assurance as to whether the financial statements are free of material misstatement. Our procedures included examination of evidence supporting the amounts disclosed in the financial statements. These procedures have been undertaken to form an opinion as to whether, in all material respects, the financial statements are presented fairly in accordance with Australian statements of accounting concepts and standards so as to present a view which is consistent with our understanding of the Albury Sub Branch's financial position and results of operations. The audit opinion expressed in this report has been formed on the above basis.

Audit Opinion

In our opinion, the financial statements present fairly the financial position of the -Construction Forestry Mining & Energy Union - Albury Sub Branch for the year ended 31st December, 2003, and the result of operations for the year then ended in accordance with Statements of Accounting Concepts and applicable Accounting Standards.

We are also of the opinion that:-

- The organisation kept satisfactory accounting records for the year ended 31st December 2003, including
- a) Records of the sources and nature of the income of the organisation (including income from members) and

- b) Records of the nature and purpose of the expenditure of the organisation
- 2. Officers of the organisation supplied all necessary explanations and information as required
- 3. The Accounts and Statements prepared gave a true and fair view of:-
- a) The financial situation of the organisation at the 31st December 2003 and
- b) The income and expenditure, and any surplus or deficit of the organisation for the year.

Note:

The Construction Forestry Mining & Energy Union – Albury Sub Branch is required to lodge an Annual GST Return if at least one quarterly Business Activity Statement (BAS) using the GST instalment amount is lodged. A reconciliation of the GST should be undertaken at the time the Annual GST Return is lodged. It should be noted that the financial reports are prepared over a calender year, whilst GST is equired to be reported on a financial year basis.

Thank you for lodging the financial report and statements of the above sub-Branch which were received in the Registry on 23 December 2005.

Your accompanying letter raises several issues concerning both the financial statements themselves, and also the Sub-Branch and so I would appreciate it if you could advise the Registry as to the following matters.

The financial statements themselves

- (1) Were the members of the Sub-Branch provided copies of the report, and if so, when?
- (2) Were the documents "presented" to a meeting of the Pulp & Paper Workers' Branch Committee, as contemplated by the former s279(6) of the Act, and if so, can you confirm the date of such meeting?
- (3) If either of the above have not yet occurred, can you indicate when these events can take place?

The Sub-Branch

- (1) Will the financial return for year ended 31 December 2004, although submitted by the Branch rather than the Sub-Branch, clearly identify any financial affairs separately incurred or conducted by the Sub-Branch during that period?
- (2) Is it the Branch's intention that until the current suspended status of the Sub-Branch Committee changes, the sub-Branch will not have any separate financial affairs?
- (3) If so, has the Branch considered whether an exemption from financial reporting obligations under s271 for the Sub-Branch might be appropriate if it is possible? (I attach an extract of the section)
- (4) Alternatively, has the Branch considered whether it might be appropriate for the organisation to seek from the Registrar a determination pursuant to sections 245

and 246 that the Sub-Branch is not a reporting entity for the purposes of the RAO legislation, while its current status persists?

I attach an extract of the relevant sections. It appears such an application would involve the making of appropriate rule alterations at either the Divisional or National level or both.
