- 5. lodgment of copies of the financial documents in the Industrial Registry under cover of a certificate by you in compliance with section 280(1) such certificate should confirm that the documents so lodged are copies of the documents presented to the meeting referred to in step 4 above the type of meeting and the date when it was held should be specified

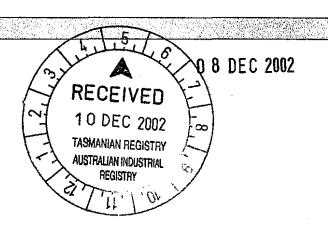

# NOTES TO THE FINANCIAL STATEMENTS FOR THE YEAR ENDED 31ST DECEMBER 2001

### **NOTE 1 - ACCOUNTING METHODS**

In accordance with generally accepted accounting principles for organisations, the financial reports are prepared on an accruals basis. Otherwise, the accounts are prepared under the historical cost convention and in accordance with Australian Accounting Standards and UIG Consesus Views issued by the joint professional accounting bodies.

In particular:

- (a) The accounts have not been adjusted to record either changes in the general purchasing power of the dollar or in the prices of particular assets.
- (b) Depreciation of fixed assets is calculated on the straight line basis in order to write the assets off over their useful life.
- (c) No provision for income tax is necessary as "Trade Unions" are exempt from income tax under Section 23 (f) of the Income Tax Assessment Act.

### NOTE 2 - INFORMATION TO BE PROVIDED TO MEMBERS OR REGISTRAR

In accordance with the requirements of the Workplace Relations Act 1996, the attention of members is drawn to the provisions of sub-sections (1), (2) and (3) of Section 274, which read as follows:

- (1) A member of an organisation, or a Registrar, may apply to the organisation for specified prescribed information in relation to the organisation.
- (2) An organisation shall, on application made under sub-section (1) by a member of the organisation or a Registrar, make the specified information available to the member or Registrar in such a manner, and within such time, as is prescribed.
- (3) A Registrar may only make an application under sub-section (1) at the request of a member of the organisation concerned, and the Registrar shall provide to a member information received because of an application made at the request of the member.
